It can be enjoyed with shellfish, fish or terrine and can be cellared up to five years or more in good conditions.</i>

<i>VDR is short for “Very Dark Red”. A blend of Petite Sirah and Petit Verdot, this wine is full-bodied yet supple, with deep, ripe fruit flavors of black currant and black raspberry..</i>
